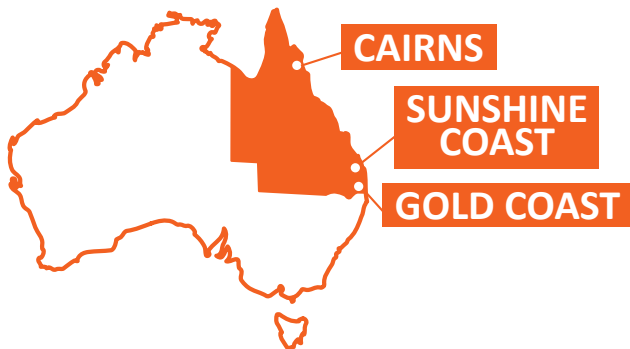

- Not work for more than 40 hours over any two consecutive weeks during course sessions.
- Maintain Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC).
- Inform DHA if they change their student status.
- Inform DHA if they withdraw from the course that they are enrolled in.
- Extend their student visa before it expires.
- Inform DHA and ICQ of current address details at all times.
